**ENTRAVISION COMMUNICATIONS CORPORATION TO BROADCAST  
WORLD CUP ON LAS VEGAS RADIO AND TELEVISION STATIONS**

**LAS VEGAS, NEVADA – June 7, 2006** – Entravision Communications Corporation (NYSE: EVC) announced today it will broadcast World Cup soccer games on its radio and television stations serving the Las Vegas, Nevada market. Coverage begins airing June 9 and continues through the final game on July 9, and will air on radio station KQRT La Tricolor 105.1 FM and television stations KINC UNIVISION Channel 15 and KELV TELEFUTURA Channel 27.

“The broadcast of World Cup games in Las Vegas represents our continued commitment to providing our dedicated listeners with the highest quality Spanish-language programming,” said Chris Roman, General Manager of Entravision’s Las Vegas media properties. “As we get closer to kick-off, we are seeing increased enthusiasm from both our listeners and sponsors and look forward to a successful World Cup for all of our constituents.”

National and local advertisers sponsoring the event include General Motors, Verizon Wireless, Jack in the Box, Budweiser, Corona Beer, Sunrise Auto, Joshua’s Auto Repair and Coast Casinos. Broadcasting rights were made available through Futbol de Primera and Univision on an exclusive basis. Terms of the broadcasting rights were not disclosed.

Entravision Communications Corporation is a diversified Spanish-language media company utilizing a combination of television, radio and outdoor operations to reach approximately 75% of Hispanic consumers across the United States, as well as the border markets of Mexico. Entravision is the largest affiliate group of both the top-ranked Univision television network and Univision’s TeleFutura network, with television stations in 20 of the nation’s top 50 Hispanic markets. Entravision owns and operates one of the nation’s largest groups of primarily Spanish-language radio stations, consisting of 52 owned and operated radio stations in 20 U.S. markets. Entravision’s outdoor advertising operations consist of approximately 10,600 advertising faces located primarily in Los Angeles and New York.
